

School Area Traffic Safety

INSTRUCTIONS WHILE ON A CITY SHUTTLE

These instructions ensure the safety and well being of all students on the City shuttle and to assist the driver in the safe operation of the school bus vehicle.

1. Be on time at the designated school bus stop; help keep the bus on schedule.
2. Stay off the road at all times while waiting for the bus.
3. Do not move toward the bus until the bus has been brought to a complete stop.
4. Do not leave your seat while the bus is in motion.
5. Keep hands and head inside the bus at all times.
6. Do not throw anything out the bus windows.
7. Remember that loud talking and laughing or unnecessary confusion divert the driver's attention and could result in a serious accident.
8. Treat bus equipment as you would valuable furniture in your own home. Never tamper with the bus or any of its equipment.
9. Assist in keeping the bus safe and sanitary at all times.
10. Keep books, packages, coats, and all other objects out of the aisles and away from emergency exits.
11. Your safety on the school bus depends on how well you conduct yourself as well as how the driver performs his or her responsibilities.
12. The driver also has rules that must be followed and unsafe driving practices or inappropriate conduct should be reported to the school principal.
13. Do not leave books, lunches or other articles on the bus.
14. Be courteous to fellow pupils and the bus driver.
15. Do not ask the driver to stop at places other than the regular bus stop.
16. Know and observe the rules.
17. Respect the instructions of the driver of your shuttle. To earn respect, you must first show respect.
